

Checklist for Montana Teenpreneur Challenge

Before submitting an entry, refer to the links titled <i>Evaluation Criteria</i> and <i>Submission Guide</i> on the contest homepage.
If you are submitting as a team, designate a team leader who will be the primary contact for your entry. This person will create your online submission credentials.
Make a 2-minute (or less) video pitch. See FAQ for details.
Write a 1,000 words (or fewer) Business Plan Summary. See FAQ for details.
Have Parent/Guardian and Student complete the Release Waiver Form. Once completed, it must be scanned as a PDF and uploaded during the submission process. If a team submits an entry, a single PDF containing all of the students' forms must be uploaded.
When ready to submit an entry, make sure to have available the teacher's or adult sponsor's preferred contact phone number and email address.
 Remember these important dates. October 1st Contest opens November 1st Submitting by this date makes you eligible to be assigned a mentor. Entry can be resubmitted thereafter. December 1st Contest closes
